 - Intractable disease with unknown cause
 - Dysphonia due to involuntary intermittent tremor of intralaryngea muscle during phonation
 - No lesion nor paralysis in vocal cord
 - Phoniatrics and psychotherapy ineffective
 - No curative treatment available globally to date
- Jul 2015: Investigator initiated trial (Kumamoto Univ., etc.)
- Feb 2016: 1st SAKIGAKE* designation for medical device
- Sep 2016: Orphan designation
- Jun 2017: Japanese NDA filed
- Dec 2017: Approved in Japan (First among SAKIGAKE designated products)
- Jun 2018: National Health Insurance listed
- Jul 2018: Launch in Japan
